- Superior six-ply wall-joint including two 78-mil thick steel bars



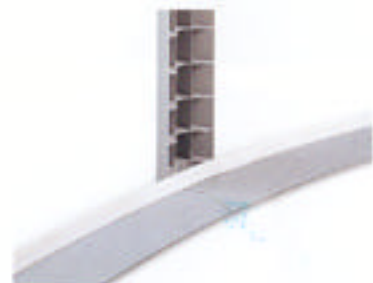
Injection molding

Patented UNILOK construction increases the strength and performance by evenly absorbing water pressure. Components interconnect precisely without any adjustments required, making Milliniad the strongest aboveground pool money can buy.



Built-in cove

All vinyl liners must have a cove. The Milliniad built-in cove will not only add years to the life of your pool, it will also save on the installation time needed. Most importantly, its permanent structure prevents your liner from tearing or leaking due to cove washout or erosion. In addition, the Milliniad built-in cove supports the entire weight on a wider foundation than conventional aboveground pools.



WATER SAFETY

The purchase of an aboveground pool provides years of pleasure and fun, but it also involves water safety. Although we cannot supply a full time lifeguard, we strongly recommend that you implement the following safety rules. These will help provide a pleasant atmosphere for you and your family.

- NEVER jump or dive in an aboveground pool.
- Maintain constant adult supervision when children are in or near any body of water.
- Read all of the safety, installation, and maintenance

information contained in the instruction manual and Water Safety brochure before you start installing your pool.

- Ask your city about any specific rules and regulations that apply to aboveground pools.
- Follow the instruction manual and maintenance instructions.
- Never remove applied or posted safety stickers or signs from your pool or pool area.
- Barriers to prevent unimpeded access, especially by young children, should be built, installed and checked on a

regular basis to ensure they are in good working order.

- Inspect your pool, barriers, alarms, and other related equipment on a regular basis in order to ensure they are in good working order and that they are safe.

The installation, maintenance and safety manual contains detailed tips and recommendations. They must be read, followed and applied on a regular basis, as they will prevent unnecessary accidents and will ensure many summers of pleasant, safe family fun.
